NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the 2018

SRO In exercise of the powers conferred by the provision to article 309 of the constitution, and in suppression of the Military Engineer Services (Non-Industrial, Class-III) Recruitment Rules, 2008, in so far as they relate to the post of Civilian Motor Driver (Special Grade) except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Civilian Motor Driver in the Military Engineer Services, namely:-

1. **Short title and commencement:** - (1) These rules may be called the Military Engineer Services (Civilian Motor Driver) Recruitment Rules, 2018.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. **Application:** - These rules shall apply to the post specified in Column 1 of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. **Number of Posts, classification and Level in the Pay Matrix:** - The number of said posts, their classification and level in the Pay Matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in Column 2 to 4 of the Schedule attached to these rules.

4. **Method of Recruitment, age limit and other qualification etc:** - The method of recruitment, age limit, qualification and other matters relating to the said posts shall be as specified in Column 5 to 13 of the Schedule aforesaid.

5. **Disqualification:** - No person,-
(a) Who have entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or
(b) Who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,
shall be eligible for appointment to any said posts.

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of the rule.

6. **Power to relax:**- Where the Central Government is of opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may by order, and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

7. **Savings:** - Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, the Other Backward Classes, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons, in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
