3. Officers planned for CWE appointments in cut-off Dec 2017 but TOS subsequently due to procedural delay in approval will be considered for planning **to ensure compliance of CVC guidelines, however they will be turned over only after completion of their present tenure.**

4. **No officer shall be allowed to continue in sensitive appointment beyond three years. Therefore officers completing their tenure before cut-off date or before next mass turnover may be considered for planning of turnover before cut-off dates.** Such officers, however, will be turned over on completion of physical tenure of sensitive appointment as per CVC guidelines.

5. Duration of staff and executive tenures at Leh Complex/Region will be of two years (24 months), irrespective of length of service of the civilian MES personnel. **Officer may forward their repatriation performa if not already fwd. One copy of Repatriation performa be sent directly to DG (Pers) Directorate.**


6. All officers TOS on or before the cut- off dates will be due for turnover. Officers at tenure/hard stations will be turned over after completion of tenure liability as applicable.

7. Duration of posting on **compassionate ground is two years (24 months)**, officers posted on compassionate ground will accordingly be considered for posting.

8. Postings on compassionate grounds and other administrative grounds and in org interest will continue to be issued as and when necessary.

9. Officer opting for present duty station as Last Leg choice station after completion of normal tenure will not be accommodated in same station. Officer has to plan Last Leg posting accordingly and submit choice station accordingly. However, in case of tenure/hard station, case may be considered on merit if there is no optee.
10. Officers who have not done tenure/hard stn in present rank, will be considered tenure/hard station posting as per tenure seniority drawn in terms of Para 19(h) of posting policy. **No separate warning list of the officer will be issued.** Postings will be based on availability of vacancies and volunteers (as applicable).
11. Officer may also volunteer for Tenure stations/Hard stations. List of tenure stations for various ranks and cadres is as per posting policy dated 09 Oct 2015. **The volunteer officer may submit their request by 10 Sep 2019.**
12. Officers due for turnover in staff may forward their choice stations in terms of Para 30 (b) of posting policy. **The requests may be fwd by 10 Sep 2019.**
13. **Permanent disability cases, to inform well in advance in terms of Para 20 of posting policy.**
14. **No TA/DA will be admissible to officer requesting premature move on posting, including Compassionate Ground and Last Leg posting cases. This is in terms of SR-114 issued by G.O.I.M.F.**
