NOTIFICATION

S.R.O. 305. In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the Military Engineer Services (Non-Industrial Group 'C' and Group 'D' posts) Recruitment Rules, 1971, in so far as they relate to posts of Supervisor Barrack/Stores Grade I, Supervisor Barrack/Stores Grade II, Storekeeper Grade I and Storekeeper Grade II, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Supervisor Barrack/Stores Grade I, Supervisor Barrack/Stores Grade II, Storekeeper Grade I, Storekeeper Grade II in the Military Engineer Services, Ministry of Defence, namely:-

1. Short title and commencement. - (1) These rules may be called the Military Engineer Services (Barrack/Stores Group 'C' Non-Industrial posts) Recruitment Rules, 1989.  
(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. Number of posts, classification and scale of pay. - The number of the said posts, their classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the said schedule.
3. Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications, etc. - The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said posts shall be as specified in columns 5 to 14 of the said schedule.
4. Disqualification: - No person, -
  - (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or
  - (b) who having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,shall be eligible for appointment to any of the said posts;

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rules.


5. Power to relax.- Where the Central Government is of opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may by order for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Saving.- Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.


