S.R.O. 309 - In exercise of the powers conferred by article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes following rules regulating the method of recruitment to class IV non-industrial posts in the Military Engineering Service:-

1. Short title and commencement - (1) These rules may be called the Military Engineering Services (Non-industrial Class III and Class IV posts) Recruitment Rules 1971.

2. They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Application :- These rules shall apply to the posts as specified in column 1 of the Schedule annexed hereto.

3. Classification and Scale of Pay :- The classification of the said posts and the scales of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 and 3 of the said Schedule.

4. Method of Recruitment, age limit, qualifications etc :- The method of recruitment to the said posts, age limit, qualifications and other matters connected therewith shall be as specified in columns 4 to 12 of the Schedule aforesaid.

Provided that the upper age limit may be relaxed in the case of candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders of the Central Government issued from time to time.

5. Disqualification - No person,

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living or,

(b) who, having a spouse living has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment.

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of the rule.

6. Power to Relax - Where the Central Government is of opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect any class or category of persons or posts.
