MILITARY ENGINEER SERVICES NOTICE OF TENDER

- 1. A tender is invited for the works [see Appendix-'A'].
- 2. The tender shall be based as mentioned in Appendix'A'.
- 3. The work is estimated to cost [see Appendix-'A']. This estimate however, is not a guarantee and is merely given as a rough guide. If the work costs more or less, the tenderer will have no claim on this account.
- 4. The work is to be completed as per the period [See Appendix 'A' in accordance with phasing if any indicated in the tender] from the date of handing over the site.
- 5. Normally contractors whose names are on the MES approved list for the command/ area in which the work lies and within whose financial category the estimated amount would fall may tender.
