

MILITARY ENGINEER SERVICES
NOTICE INVITING TENDER (NIT)

1. A tender is invited for (see Appendix 'A').
2. The tender shall be based on (see Appendix 'A').
3. The work is estimated to cost (see Appendix 'A'). This estimates however is not a guarantee and is merely given as a rough guide. If the work costs more or less, the tenderer will have no claim on this account.
4. The work is to be completed within the period as indicated in the aforesaid Appendix 'A' from the date of handing over site which may be about two weeks after the date of acceptance of the tender.
- 5.1 Normally contractors whose names are on the MES approved list for the area in which the work lies and within whose financial category the estimated amount would fall may tender. But in case of term contracts, contractors in category 'SS' to 'E' may tender. In case where the tendered amount is in excess of the financial category of the contractor, the Accepting Officer reserves the right to accept the tender, in which event the tenderer would be required to lodge additional security deposit as notified by the Accepting Officer in terms of conditions of contract.
- 5.2 Contractors whose names are borne on the MES approved list of any MES formations and who have deposited Standing Security and have executed standing Security Bond, may also tender without depositing Earnest Money along with the tender and if the Accepting Officer proposes to accept the tender, such tenderers would be required to deposit "Security Deposit" as notified by the Accepting Officer within 30 days on receipt of notification of Acceptance of tender failing which the sum shall be recovered from first RAR payment or from the first Final bill.
- 5.3 Not more than one tender shall be submitted by one contractor, or one firm of Contractors.
- 5.4 Under no circumstances will a father and his son(s) or other close relations who have business dealing with one another will be allowed to tender for the same contract as separate competitors. A breach of this condition will render the tender of both parties liable to rejection.
- 5.5 Invitation for applications for issue of tender does not constitute any guarantee for issue of tender to the applicant, even to enlisted Contractor of appropriate class. Issue of tender will be decided by the Accepting Officer based on interalia past track record, financial position and experience of similar works executed by the applicant/Contractor. The Accepting Officer shall consider applications received on website www.defproc.gov.in till the date of receipt of application/extended date of receipt of applications for issue of tender. The applicant/contractor will be informed regarding non-issue of tender. The applicant/contractor, if he so desires may appeal to the next higher Engineer authority with copy to the Accepting officer. No appeal/representation shall be entertained in respect of applications for issue of tenders as received after the due date of receipt of applications/extended date of receipt of applications. The decision of the next higher Engineer authority shall be final. No applicant /Contractor shall be entitled for any compensation whatsoever for rejection of his application.
6. The Chief Engineer Kolkata Zone, Kolkata will be the Accepting Officer herein- after referred to as such for the purpose of this contract.

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7. The cost of tender forms/documents (in blank) (see Appendix 'A') shall be in the form of 'Demand Draft' from any nationalised Bank/Scheduled Bank in favour of Garrison Engineer (see Appendix 'A') shall be attached to the application requesting for issue of tender by the tenderer. Applications for the tender forms with Demand Draft must be submitted to the HQ Chief Engineer Kolkata Zone so as to reach this office by the date as mentioned in the aforesaid Appendix 'A'. The Demand Draft shall be non-refundable if the application for issue of tender forms is accepted. However, the DD shall be returned to the applicant by the Accepting Officer in case the tender form is not issued. The tenderer/contractor shall bear the cost of bank charges for procuring and encashing the Bank Demand Draft and he shall not have any claim whatsoever on this account on Govt. The applicant shall not become automatically entitled for issue of tender by virtue of enclosing demand draft along with the application and the Accepting Officer shall reserve the right to deny issue of tender to any applicant.

8. Tender forms and conditions of contracts and other necessary documents will be available on website www.defproc.gov.in.

9. The appropriate Standing Security amount for this work shall be as deposited by Contractors enlisted in the Command in which work lies for. In case of a Contractors who has not executed the Standing Security Bond, the tender shall be accompanied by earnest money amounting to (See Appendix 'A') in the form of deposit at Call receipt issued in favour of GE concerned from a Schedule Bank or in the form of receipted treasury Challan, the amount being credited to the revenue deposit of the Garrison Engineer (See Appendix 'A').

9.1 A contractor who is not enlisted for the area in which the work lies, but whose name is in the MES approved list of any MES formation and who has deposited standing security and executed standing security bond may tender without depositing earnest money alongwith the tender but if the Accepting Officer decides to accept the tender, such tenderer shall lodge security deposit as notified by the Accepting Officer with the Controller of Defence Account concerned, in the prescribed form within thirty days on receipt of notification of acceptance of the tender the additional amount as mentioned in the aforesaid Appendix 'A' failing which the sum will be recovered from the first RAR payment or from the first final bill in case of term/running contracts, However, in case where any payments is made to the contractor within thirty days of the receipt by him of notification of acceptance of tender the amount of additional security shall be recovered from such payment.

9.2 A contractor who has executed the Standing Security Bond but not for the appropriate category as mentioned above, shall lodge with the Accepting Officer concerned Additional Security Deposit as notified by the Accepting Officer within 30 days of the receipt by him of notification of acceptance of tender, failing which this sum will be recovered from the first RAR payment or from the first final bill in the case of term/running contracts. However in cases where any payment is made to the contractors with in 30 days of the receipt by him of notification of acceptance of tender, the amount of additional security deposit shall be recovered from such payments.

9.3 The GE will return the earnest Money wherever applicable to all unsuccessful tenderers by endorsing authority and deposit receipt for its refund on production by the tenderer a certificate of the Accepting Officer that a bonafide tender (vide condition 17 hereinafter) was received and all documents were returned. The GE will either return the earnest Money to the successful tenderer by endorsing on the deposit receipt for its refund on receipt of an appropriate amount of security deposit or will retain the same on account of part of security deposit if such a transaction is feasible.

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10. Copies of the drawings and the documents pertaining to the work signed for the purpose of identification by the Accepting Officer or his accredited representative and sample of materials and stores to be supplied by the Contractor will be opened for the inspection at the concerned GE office (See Appendix 'A') during office working hours.

11. The tenderer are advised to inspect/visit and examine the site and its surroundings by making prior appointment with the GE in sufficient times and satisfy themselves before submitting their tenders as to the nature of the ground and subsoil (so far as is practicable), the form and nature of the site, the means of access to the site, the accommodation they may require and in general shall themselves obtain all necessary information as to risks, contingencies and other circumstances which may influence or affect their tender. A tenderer shall be deemed to have full knowledge of the site whether he inspects it or not and no extra charges consequent on any misunderstanding or otherwise shall be allowed. The tenderer shall be responsible for arranging and maintaining at his own cost all materials, tools & plants, water, electricity, access facilities for workers and all other services required for executing the work unless otherwise specifically provided for in the contract documents. The online submission of tender/Price bid by a tenderer implies that he has read this notice and all other contract documents and has made himself aware of the scope and specifications of the work to be done, local conditions and other factors having a bearing on the execution of the work. **This is a tender of balance work left over by previous contractor. The quantum of balance work of bldg shall be accessed by the contractor and quote accordingly. No claim on misrepresentation of work done shall be entertained.**

12. The price bids (Cover 2) shall be opened online by the opening officers at the specified date & time as provided in critical dates and the result will be displayed on www.defproc.gov.in in which can be seen by all the bidders who participated in the tenders.

13. Tender of any tenderer who proposes any alternation to any of the conditions laid down or who proposes any other condition of any description whatsoever is liable to be rejected.

14. The Submission of tender by a tenderer implies that he has read this notice and the condition of contract and has made himself aware of the scope and specifications of work to be done and of the conditions and the rates at which stores, tools and plants etc will be issued to him and local conditions and other factors having bearing on the execution of the work.

15. Tenderers must be in possession of a copy of the MES standard schedule of rates Part-I, 2009 and Part-II, 2010 including errata and amendments there to, IAFW-2249 (1989 print) and Schedule of Minimum fair wages of State and Central wherein maximum of two will be payable to labourer in case both conflict in the work execution area and specifications.

16. Tenderer must be very careful to upload BOQ. An authorised signatory must satisfy each and every condition laid down in the document to make it a bonafide tender.

17. The Accepting Officer does not bind himself to accept the lowest or any tender to give any reasons for not doing so.

18. This notice of tender shall form part of the contract.

(b) For Un- : Contractor not enlisted with MES will be required to upload the
enlisted contractors following necessary documents to prove their eligibility :-

(i) Demand draft / Banker's Cheque for Rs. 2000/- issued by nationalised / Scheduled Bank in favour of Garrison Engineer (N) Kolkata towards tender Cost.

(ii) An application form requested tender document indicating valid email ID signed by authorised person.

(iii) Demand Draft / Banker's Cheque for Rs. **4,25,000/-** issued by nationalised / Scheduled Bank in favour of Garrison Engineer (N) Kolkata towards Earnest Money Deposit

(iv) The following documents meeting the enlistment criteria of MES :-

(a) Satisfactorily completed two works costing not less than Rs. 4.00 Crores or one work costing not less than Rs. 6.00 Crores.

(c) Solvent upto Rs. 2.00 Crore or financial sound for engagement upto Rs. 7.50 Crore.

(d) **Minimum movable or immovable property or fixed assets for Rs. 60.00 Lakhs.**

(v) Copy of Police verification certificate (with in last one year) from police authority of the area where the registered office is located. A valid passport duly notarised is also acceptable in lieu of police verification for proprietor / each partner / each director of the firm. Police verification will be carried out before accepting of the contract in case contract being awarded.

APPENDIX 'A' TO E-NOTICE OF TENDER**Notes :**

(i) Application received without scanned copy of requisite amount of demand draft towards tender cost along with necessary documents as mentioned above shall not be considered their financial bid. The cost of tender documents shall be non-refundable if the application for financial bid considered after scrutiny and selection. However, it shall be returned to the applicants in case if the applicant is not qualified and whose Cover 2 is not considered / opened. The contractor shall bear the cost of Bank Charges for procuring and en-cashing the Bank Draft. The applicant shall also renew or forward fresh DD at his own cost on demand on Accepting Officer in case of extending due date of opening of financial bid or due to recall of tender, failing which applicant's request for participating in financial bid shall be rejected and he shall not have any claim whatsoever on this account on Govt.

(ii) The applicant contractor shall not become automatically entitled for participating financial bid by virtue of enclosing demand draft towards tender cost along with the application and the Accepting Officer shall reserve the right to deny any applicant.

(iii) The applicant / Contractor will be informed regarding non opening of cover 2 (Price bid). The applicant/ contractor, if he so desires, may appeal to the next Higher Engineer authority with copy to the Accepting officer. No appeal / representation shall be entertained in respect of applications for issue of tender as received after the due date of submission of applicants (Cover 1) / extended date of receipt of applications (Cover 1). The decision of the next Higher Engineer Authority shall be final. No applicant/contractor shall be entitled for any compensation whatsoever for rejection of his application / non opening of cover No 2 (Price bid).

(iv) For submission of e-tender bidders are requested to get themselves registered with defproc.gov.in website alongwith class II/III digital Signature Certificate (DSC) issued by authorised CA under IT Act 2003.

(v) Application not accompanied by requisite value DD/Banker Cheque towards cost of tender shall not be considered. Price bid (Cover 2) received without EMD in original (if applicable as required) will not be opened.

Note : Original DD/BC for cost of tender and Earnest Money scanned and uploaded online for prequalification in Cover No 1 must reach to this office physically before due date and time of bid opening, otherwise firm will not be qualified for opening of Cover 1 and Price bid will not be opened. No Claim whatsoever shall be entertained on this account.
