

MILITARY ENGINEER SERVICES
NOTICE OF TENDER

1. A tender is invited for (see Appendix 'A')
2. The work is estimated to cost (see Appendix 'A')
The estimate, however, is not a guarantee and is merely given as rough guide and if the work cost more or less, tenderer will have no claim on that account. The tender shall be based on (see Appendix 'A')
3. The work is to be completed within (see Appendix 'A') in accordance with the phasing if any, indicated in the tender from the date of handing over the site which will be on or after (see Appendix 'A')
4. The scanned copy of application for the tender document(s), DD/banker cheque and other relevant documents should be uploaded on MES e-procurement site. But the original application along with DD/Banker cheque as cost of tender must be submitted to Garrison Engineer Faizabad so as reach this office on or before opening of bid failing which the application may be rejected and tenderer will not be allowed to participate in second state (Price bid).
5. Normally contractors whose names are on the MES approved list for the area in which the work lies, and within whose financial category the estimated amount would fall, may tender but in case of term contract, contractors in categories 'SS' to 'E' may tender. In case, where the tender amount is in excess of the financial limit of the contractor and the Accepting Officer reserve the right to accept the tender, in which event the tenderer would be required to lodge Additional Security Deposit as notified by the Accepting Officer in terms of conditions of contract. Not more than one tender shall be submitted by one contractor or one firm of contractors. Under no circumstances will a father and his son(s) or their close relations who have business dealing with one another be allowed to tender for the same contract as separate competitor. A breach of this condition will render tenders of both parties liable to rejection.
6. The Garrison Engineer Faizabad will be the Accepting Officer herein after referred to as such, for the purpose of this contract.
7. Tender forms and conditions of contracts and other necessary document can be downloaded on and after (See Appendix 'A') to approved contractors. The appropriate standing security for this work shall be deposited by the contractors enlisted for (See Appendix 'A'). In the case of a contractor who has not executed the standing security bond the tenderer shall upload scanned copy of paid Earnest Money amounting to (See Appendix 'A') in the form of deposit-call receipt issued in favour of Garrison Engineer by a schedule bank or a

receipted treasury Challan the amount being credited to the revenue deposit of the GE (see Appendix 'A'). A contractor who is not enlisted for the area in which the work lies, but whose name is in the MES approved list of any MES formation and who has deposited standing security bond may tender without depositing earnest money along with the tender, but if the accepting officer decided to accept the tender, such tenderer shall lodge a security deposit equal to the amount as indicated in above in concerned Controller of Defence Accounts before acceptance of tender.

8. A contractor, who has executed standing security bond, but not for this appropriate category as mentioned above, shall lodge with the Controller of Defence Accounts concerned additional security deposit as notified by the Accepting Officer within thirty days of the receipt of notification of acceptance of his tender failing which the sum will be recovered from the first RAR or from the first final bill in the case of term/running contracts. The GE will return the earnest money wherever applicable to unsuccessful tenderers by endorsing authority of the deposit receipt for its return. GE will either return the earnest money to the successful tenderer by endorsing an authority on the deposit receipt of an equal amount of security deposit or will retain the same on account of security deposit if such transaction is feasible. Copies of the drawings and other documents pertaining to the work signed for the purpose of notification by the Accepting Officer or his accredited representative and sample of material and stores to be supplied by the contractor will be opened for inspection by the tenderers at the following offices during working hours (See Appendix 'A')
9. The tenderer are advised to inspect/visit and examine the site and its surroundings by making prior appointment with the GE in sufficient times and satisfy themselves before submitting their tenders as to the nature of the ground and subsoil (so far as is practicable), the form and nature of the site, the means of access to the site, the accommodation they may require and in general shall themselves obtain all necessary information as to risks, contingencies and other circumstances which may influence or affect their tender. A tenderer shall be deemed to have full knowledge of the site whether he inspects it or not and no extra charges consequent on any misunderstanding or otherwise shall be allowed. The tenderer shall be responsible for arranging and maintaining at his own cost all materials tools & plants, water, electricity, access facilities for workers and all other services required for executing the work unless otherwise specifically provided for in the contract documents. The online submission of tender/Price bid by a tenderer implies that he has read this notice and all other contract documents and has made himself aware of the scope and specifications of the work to be done and of the conditions and rates at which materials, tools and plants etc will be issued to him, local conditions and other factors having a bearing on the execution of the work.

10. The accepting authority on behalf of the President of India does not bind himself to accept the lowest or any other tender, and reserves to himself the authority to reject any or all of the tenders received without the assignment of any reason. All tenders, in which any of the prescribed conditions is not fulfilled or any condition including that of conditional rebate /rebate is put forth by the tenderer, shall be summarily rejected.
11. The tender shall be based on (See Appendix 'A').
12. Under no circumstances will father and his sons/or other close relations, who have business dealing with one another be allowed to tender for the same contract as separate competition. Breach of this condition will render the tenders of both parties liable to rejection.
13. The Price Bids will be opened online by the opening officer / officers at the specified date & time (See Appendix 'A') and the result will be displayed on the www.defprocs.gov.in, which can be seen by all the bidders who participated in the tenders.
14. Any tender which proposes any alternations to any of the conditions laid down or which propose any other conditions of any description whatsoever/is liable to be rejected.
15. The Accepting Officer does not bind himself to accept the lowest tender of any tenderer or to give the reasons for not doing so.
16. This letter shall form part of the tender documents.

	(b) For the Contractors	(a) The firms not enlisted with MES shall meet the enlistment criteria of 'E' Class MES contractor & category d (i) (Furniture works) i.e with regard to having satisfactorily completed requisite value works, Annual turnover, Solvency, Working capital, immovable property/ fixed assets, T&P, Engineering establishment, no recovery outstanding in any Govt Department, Police verification/Passport etc. Enlistment criteria may be seen in Para1.4 Section 1 of Part I of MES Manual on Contracts -2007 (Reprint 2012) as available in all MES formations. (b) These firms shall also submit copy of police verification from police authority of the area where the registered office of the firm is located/notarized copy of valid passport of proprietor/each partner/each Director. (c) They should not carry adverse remarks in WLR/or any other similar report of any authority.

1. Interested bidders are requested to refer MES e procurement portal www.defproc.gov.in, sub title bidders manual kit for details.
2. The bidder enlisted in MES one class below the eligible class given above may also submit bids. The accepting officer may consider such bids in case of inadequate response from eligible class contractors.
3. Tender not accompanied by requisite value DD/Bankers Cheque towards cost of tender shall not be considered.
4. Contractors enlisted with MES will submit following documents for checking eligibility:-
 - (a) Scanned copy of application and their enlistment letter alongwith connected enclosures.
 - (b) Scanned copy of DD/Bankers Cheque of cost of tender.
 - (c) Scanned copy of EPF Control No.
 - (d) Scan copy of GST No.
5. The tender fees/EMD should be received in the office of the Garrison Engineer Faizabad (UP) Pin-224001 under sealed cover before the opening of Technical bid, failing which his Technical bid will not be opened and action shall be taken against the bidder as deemed fit.
6. The bidder at the bidder's own responsibility and risk is encouraged to visit and examine the site of works and its surroundings and obtain all information that may be necessary for preparing the Bid and entering into a contract for the work as mentioned in the Notice of Tender, the cost of visiting shall be at the bidder's own expense. Traffic management and execution shall be the responsibility of the Agency at his/her/their risk and cost.
7. The intending bidders shall clearly understand that whatever may be the outcome of the present invitation of bids, no cost of bidding shall be reimbursable by the Department. Garrison Engineer Faizabad (UP) Pin- 224001 reserve the right to accept/reject any/all bid documents/offer without assigning any reason whatsoever, and is not liable for any cost that might have incurred any bidder at the stage of bidding.
8. Prospective applicants are advised to note carefully the minimum qualification criteria as mentioned in instructions to bidders before bidding.
9. Bidder not enlisted with MES will be required to be enclosed necessary documents to prove their eligibility for enlistment in eligible class and category of work, including Affidavit that no recovery is outstanding. List of documents required for enlistment in MES has been given in Para 1.5 of Part-I pre contract stage section-1 MES Manual on Contracts 2007 (Reprint 2012). These bidders shall also submit scanned copy of earnest money and other documents listed in here in before.
10. In case of rejection of technical/prequalification bid, bidder may appeal to next higher Engineer authority i.e HQ CWE Allahabad, C/o 56 APO whose decision shall be final and binding. However bidders shall not be entitled to any compensation whatsoever for rejection of technical/prequalification bid.
11. The above details are also available in on MES website : www.defproc.gov.in full notice of tender IAFW-2162 and Enlistment criteria is available in all office of MES and also on MES Website.
12. In case, tender is accepted in favour of a specific firm after being lowest, the same shall be executed by the said firm only. Under no circumstances, subletting in any form shall be allowed. The 'power of Attorney' shall not be accepted and allowed.
13. Court of the place from where tender has been issued shall alone have jurisdiction to decide any dispute out of or in respect of this tender. After acceptance of tender, Condition 72- jurisdiction of Courts of IAFW-2249 shall be applicable.
14. The bidder registered with MSME Act 2012 including amendment upto date should have Udyog Aadhar Memorandum number (UAM) by the vendors on CPPP mandatory in the light of E-in-C's branch letter No 66546/Manual/IPPP/E8/31 dt 17 May 2018 and should not be exempted from tender fee and EMD upto his enlisted capacity in the light of E-in-C's branch letter No 66546/Manual/IPPP/29/E8 dt 28 Nov 2017.
15. It is mandatory for the contractors to upload their GST registration Number along with the T bid in cover1. Contractor who failed to upload GST registration Number shall be disqualified in 'T' bid evaluation and his financial bid shall not be opened. No claim what so ever shall be entertained on this account.
- 16 (a) Contractor one class below (two class below in case of remote and difficult area) may also bid for this tender. Their application shall be considered subject to fulfillment of other eligibility criteria given in NIT when number of applicants of eligible class qualifying for the tender are less than 7 (seven).
- (b) In case number of eligible class contractors satisfying the eligibility criteria given in NIT are 7 or more than 7, application of one class below the eligible class shall not be considered except those who have previously completed similar works satisfactory and are meeting the criteria of up gradation in respect of past experience and / or average annual turnover as applicable and financial soundness (solvency / financial soundness and working capital) provided the value of work is less than twice the tendering limit of such contractors. Contractors one class below the eligible class may upload necessary documents wrt works experience and financial soundness in cover 1 of tender (T bid).
- (c) (i) Applications/bids not accompanied by scanned copies of requisite DD/Bankers Cheque towards cost of tender and earnest money (as applicable) shall not be considered for validation of 'T' bid and their finance bids will not be opened.
- (ii) Contractors should ensure that their original DDs and earnest money (as applicable) are received within 05 days of bid submission end date.
- (iii) In case of applications / bids from enlisted contractors of MES, where scanned copies of requisite DD/Bankers Cheque towards cost of tender has been uploaded but physical copies are not received by the stipulated date, their finance bids will be opened. However non-submission of physical copies of cost of tender shall be considered as willful negligence of the bidder with ulterior motives and such bidder shall be banned from bidding for a period of six months commencing form the date of opening of finance bid (cover 2).

(iv) In case of applications / bids from un-enlisted contractors, where scanned copies of requisite DD / Bankers Cheque towards cost of tender has been uploaded but physical copies are not received by the stipulated date, finance bids will not be opened. Name of such contractors along with complete address shall be circulated for not opening of their bids for a period of six months commencing from the date of opening of finance bid (cover 2).

(v) In case of applications / bids (enlisted contractor as well as un-enlisted contractor) where scanned copies of requisite Earnest money (as applicable) were uploaded but the same are not received in physical form within stipulated time, such bids shall not qualify for opening of finance bid (cover 2).

(d) Contractors may note that they shall not be loaded beyond their tendering limit as under:-

(aa) In case contractors of eligible class are selected for issue of Tender : 4 to 5 times the Tendering limit.

(bb) In case of one class (two class in case of remote and difficult area as the case may be) contractors are selected for issue of tender : 6 to 7 times

(cc) In case of un-enlisted contractors: 2 times the upper tendering limit of class for which contractor meets the criteria for enlistment.

(e) In case any deficiency is noticed, in the documents required to be uploaded by the tenderers as per NIT, after opening of cover 1 (T bid) and during technical evaluation, a communication in the form e-mail / Whatsapp / SMS/ Speed Post etc. shall be sent to the contractor to rectify the deficiency within a period of 7 days from date of communication failing which financial bid (cover -2) shall not be opened and contractor shall not have any claim on the same.

(f) Contractors enlisted with MES will upload following documents for checking eligibility:-

(i) Application for bid in firm's letter head

(ii) Enlistment letter

(iii) Scanned copy of DD of cost of Tender

(g) Contractor not enlisted with MES will be required to upload necessary documents to prove their eligibility for enlistment in eligible class and category of work, including affidavit for no recovery outstanding. List of documents required for enlistment in MES has been given in Para 1.5 of section 1 of Part I MES Manual on Contracts 2007 (reprint 2012). Following documents shall also be uploaded amongst others:-

(i) Details of three highest valued similar nature of works executed during last Five years, financial year-wise in tabular form giving name of work, Accepting officer's details, Viz, Address, Telephone, Fax No, E-mail ID etc, date of acceptance of tender and actual date of completion. This shall be duly signed by proprietor / all partners / authorized Director of Pvt / Public Ltd, as applicable. It should indicate whether extension was granted or compensation was levied. Attested copy of acceptance letter and completion certificate shall be enclosed of each work. In case performance report has been given by the client same shall be also be submitted duly attested.

(ii) Solvency certificate and working capital certificate issued by scheduled bank.

(iii) Annual turnover certificate for last 2 years issued by Chartered Accountant along with relevant pages of audited balance sheets in support thereof.

(iv) Affidavits for possession of movable & immovable properties by proprietor / partner owning the immovable property along with valuation certificate from Regd valuer in support of movable & immovable properties. In case of Limited company, the immovable property is required to be in the name of company.

(v) In addition, the un-enlisted contractor shall also furnish affidavit on non-judicial stamp paper in the form of hard copy declaring their turnover for last 2 (Two) years.

(vi) Scanned copy of DD of cost of tender and earnest money.

(vii) In case of rejection of technical / prequalification bid, Contractor may appeal to next

higher Engineer authority i.e CWE Allahabad on email alhbd3-mes@nic.in against

rejection, whose decision shall be final and binding. However contractor/ bidder shall not be entitled to any compensation whatsoever for rejection of technical/ pre-qualification bid.
