 - (ii) However, contractors enlisted in one class/two class below eligible class may also apply/bid. Applications from one class below eligible class contractors may be considered in the event of inadequate response/bids (less than seven) from the applicants of eligible class provided their past performance has been satisfactory and in the opinion of Accepting Officer they are considered capable of handling this work.
 - (iii) Applications from two class below eligible class contractors may be considered in the event of inadequate response from the applicants of eligible class and one class below eligible class taken together (less than seven) provided their past performance has been satisfactory and in the opinion of Accepting Officer they are considered capable of handling this work.
 - (iv) To infuse better competition, Accepting Officer may consider applications from one class below eligible class contractors even in the event of sufficient applications form eligible class contractors provided such contractor (s) strictly meet the criteria laid down in Section 3.5.5.2(b)(ii) of MES Manual on Contracts 2007 (Re-print-2012). The details of eligibility of such one class below contractor(s) shall be made available in public domain.
 - (v) Contractors enlisted in one class/two class below eligible class shall submit the documents such as details of three highest value similar nature works executed during last 03 years, solvency and working capital certificate, Annual turnover certificate for last two years, affidavit for possession of movable and immovable properties etc. in the manner prescribed for unenlisted contractors hereinafter in support of their capability to execute the subject work to enable Accepting Officer take a considered decision as per departmental policy.
- Contractors enlisted with MES will upload following documents (scanned copy in pdf format) for checking eligibility:-(b)
 - (i) Application for the tender on Tenderer's Letter Head. In this, the contractor should explain with calculation details supported with documentary evidence as to how he is qualifying for this tender in terms of conditions given in Para 8 (A) (a) above. Tenderer/ bidder to note that if they do not submit their calculation details and/ or supporting documents correctly, Deptt will make calculation. If the firm does not qualify as a result of Deptt calculation, then bidder only will be responsible for the same. This is notwithstanding the fact that Deptt will check the details and calculations also in respect of the contractors who have given the calculations.

Documents in support of Notes (a) (iv) & (v) shall be uploaded alongwith GST registration number by one/two class below eligible class contractors. Hard copy of these documents will be submitted within 05 days of the last date & time of opening of 'T' bid.

- Contractors not enlisted with MES will be required to upload the following:-(c)
 - (i) Application for the tender: In this the contractor should explain with calculation details supported with documentary evidence, how he is qualifying for this tender in terms of conditions given in Para 8 (B) (a) above. Tenderer/bidder to note that if they do not submit their calculation details and / or supporting documents correctly, Deptt will make calculation. If the firm does not qualify as a result of Deptt calculation, then bidder only will be responsible for the same. This is notwithstanding the fact that Deptt will check the details and calculations also in respect of the contractors who have given
 - (ii) Necessary documents to prove their eligibility for enlistment in required class & category of work, including Affidavit for no recovery outstanding. List of documents required for enlistment in MES has been given in Para 1.5 of section 1 of Part I of MES Manual of Contracts 2007 (Reprint 2012). The work experience shall include details of similar nature of works executed during last five years, financial year-wise in tabular form giving name of work, Accepting Officer's details, viz, Address, Telephone, Fax No, email ID etc, date of acceptance of tender and actual date of completion. This shall be duly signed by proprietor/ all partners / authorised Director of Pvt/ Public Ltd, as applicable. It should indicate whether extension was granted or compensation was levied. Attested copy of acceptance letter and completion certificate shall be enclosed of each work. In case performance report has been given by the client, same shall also be submitted duly attested. The documents will also include the following amongst others:-
 - (aa) Solvency certificate and working Capital Certificate issued by scheduled bank.
 - (ab) Affidavits for possession of movable & immovable properties by proprietor/partner owing the immovable property alongwith Valuation Certificate from Regd Valuer in support of movable & immovable properties. In case of Limited company, the immovable property is required to be in the name of the company.
 - Scanned copy of DD toward cost of tender and earnest money.
 - (iv) (v) Scanned Copy of GST Registration Number
 - Documents in support of residual capacity which shall include:-
 - (aa) Copy of turn over certificate from CA for last 5 (five) years (FY), notarised copy of relevant pages of balance sheet of those FYs showing the turnover (gross receipts).
 - (ab) List of works in hand for contracts with Government department & private works, completed values thereof and residual work to be completed during completion period of subject work in a self-explanatory tabular form. This shall be submitted duly signed by proprietor / all partners / authorised Director of Pvt/Public Ltd as applicable. (ac) Affidavit on non judicial stamp paper of Rs. 100/- (minimum) in the form of hard copy declaring their turnover for last 5 (five) years and value of contracts in hand in Government department & Private and details of works completed and residual work to be completed.

Hard copy of these documents shall be submitted within 05 days of the last date & time of opening of 'T' bid.

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- (d) (i) Applications/bids not accompanied by scanned copies of requisite DD/ Bankers Cheque towards cost of tender, earnest money (as applicable), GST registration number, documents in support of Note (a) (iv) & (v) and incomplete documents as mentioned in Notes above shall not be considered for validation of 'T' bid and their financial bids will not be opened. No claim whatsoever shall be entertained on this account.
 - (ii) Tenderers/bidders to note that they should ensure that their original DDs and earnest money (as applicable) are received within 5 days after last date of opening of T bid.
 - (iii) In case of applications/bids from enlisted contractors of MES, where scanned copies of requisite DD/Bankers Cheque towards cost of tender has been uploaded but physical copies are not received by the stipulated date, financial bids will be opened. However non-submission of physical copies of cost of tender shall be considered as wilful negligence of the bidder with ulterior motives and such bidder shall be banned from bidding for a period of six months commencing from the date of opening of finance bid.
 - (iv) In case of applications/bids from un-enlisted contractors, where scanned copies of requisite DD/Bankers Cheque towards cost of tender has been uploaded but physical copies are not received by the stipulated date, financial bids will not be opened. Name of such contractors alongwith complete address shall be circulated for not opening of their bids for a period of six months commencing from the date of opening of finance bid.
 - (v) In case of applications/ bids (enlisted contractor/ as well as un-enlisted contractor) where scanned copies of requisite Earnest money (as applicable) were uploaded but the same are not received in physical form within stipulated time, such bids shall not qualify for opening of financial bid.
- (e) In case of rejection of technical/ prequalification bid, contractor may appeal to HQ CE WC Chandimandir against rejection on email id dydrcontceengrcl-mes@gov.in with copy to Accepting Officer within 05 days from the date of technical bid evaluation, whose decision shall be final and binding. However contractor/ bidder shall not be entitled to any compensation whatsoever for rejection of technical/pregualification bid.
- (f) Court of the place from where tender has been issued shall alone have jurisdiction to decide any dispute out of or in respect of this tender. After acceptance of tender, Condition 72-Jurisdiction of Courts of IAFW-2249 shall be applicable.
