12. PRE QUALIFICATION CRITERIA (PQC) :

12.1 The bidder should meet the criteria with regard to completion of works (works experience of similar nature) in Central Govt/ State Govt/ PSUs, annual turnover, Solvency capacity, working capital capacity as laid down hereinafter.

12.2 Bidder should not have any recovery outstanding in any Govt Department.

12.3 Clear Police verification/Passport etc: Bidder firms shall submit copy of Police verification/clearance certificate from Police authority of the area where the registered office of the firm is located or notarised copy of valid passport of proprietor/each partner/each Director.

13. **Average Annual Turnover :** The bidder should have average annual turnover during the last 3 financial years ending 31 March of 2024 not less than 19 crore. At the time of submission of prequalification, the bidder shall upload Affidavit/Certificate from Chartered Accountant mentioning Financial Turnover and Net Worth of last 3 years. There is no need to upload entire voluminous balance sheet. However, one page of summarized balance sheet (Audited) and one page of summarized Profit & loss Account (Audited) for last 03 years shall be uploaded.

14. **Work Experience :** Bidder shall have following work experience :

(a) Experience of having successfully completed similar nature of works during last 7 years ending last day of month previous to the month of bid submission start date which should be either of the following:-

- (i) Three completed works of similar nature costing not less than 24.8 crore.
- (ii) Two completed works of similar nature costing not less than 31.00 crore.
- (iii) One completed works of similar nature costing not less than 49.60 crore..

(b) Works completed only in Central Govt/ State Govt/ PSUs shall be considered. The work must have been executed through a proper agreement between the bidder and the Company.

(c) For the purpose of valuating the amount of completed works, the value of previously completed works to be enhanced @ 5% per year to bring them at par with present cost.

(d) Works of similar nature shall mean construction of RCC framed structures multi storeyed buildings (more than 4 storeys) residential/OTM complex including finishing works and connected services like electric supply, water supply, area drainage, access and peripheral roads, sewage disposal, perimeter fencing and wall,lifts,fire fighting etc. under one contract.

15. **Financial Soundness :**

(a) Bidder shall have the solvency value not less than Rs 8.0 crore (Eight) Crore. The solvency shall be adjudged based on the solvency certificate issued by a Scheduled Bank.

(b) Bidder shall have working capital not less than Rs 3.5 crore (Three point five) Crore. The limit of working capital shall be adjudged based on the working capital certificate issued by a Scheduled Bank.

- 15.1 Necessary proforma for FORM OF SOLVENCY CERTIFICATE & WORKING CAPITAL CERTIFICATE FROM NATIONALISED/SCHEDULED BANK and DETAILS OF WORKS EXECUTED DURING LAST 07 YEARS IN CENTRAL GOVT/ STATE GOVT /PSUs, is enclosed as Annexure -I.

16. The contractor shall not sublet any portion of the contract without prior written approval of the Accepting Officer. However not more than 49% part of the work in terms of Contract value can be approved for subletting by the Accepting Officer. The contractor shall be fully responsible for any subcontract or contractors, who may carry out the sublet work. The contractor shall not execute the work through power of attorney holder on his behalf to a third party/another firm except sons/ daughter of proprietor/partner/director and firm's own employees, Director, Project Manager. This shall be subject to conditions which may have been prescribed in the NIT forming part of tender documents.

17. **Documents to be uploaded by the bidders :**

- 17.1 Application for the tender on Firm's letter Head. In this, the bidder shall explain with calculation details supported with documentary evidence as to how he is qualifying for this tender in terms of conditions given above. Tenderers /bidder is required to note that if they do not submit their calculation details and/or supporting documents correctly, MES will make calculation and the same shall be binding on the bidder. This is notwithstanding the fact that MES will check the details and calculations also in respect of the contractors who have given the calculations.

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17.2 DDs/financial instruments toward cost of tender and Earnest Money Deposit (as applicable).

17.3 Documents in to be uploaded : These shall include the following documents :

17.3.1 Cover -1

- (a) Copy of turn over certificate from CA for last 5 (Five) financial years (FY) ending 31 Mar 2024 duly indicating the UDAI number and ICAI Membership number of the Chartered Accountant issuing the certificate along with notarized copy of relevant pages of balance sheet of those FYs showing the turn over (gross receipts) as per Annexure 'I' attached.
- (b) Copies of completion certificates in three highest valued works (after adjusting the values as mentioned above) during last seven years. This will be in tabular form giving name of work, details about client/Department viz, Address, Telephone, Fax No, E-mail ID etc, date of acceptance of tender/award of work/issue of Order and actual date of completion. This signed by proprietor/all partner/authorized Director of Pvt /Public Ltd, as applicable. It should indicate whether extension was granted or compensation was levied. Attested copy of acceptance letter and completion certificate shall be enclosed of each work. In case performance report has been given by the client same shall also be submitted duly attested.
- (c) Affidavit on non-judicial stamp paper of Rs 100/- (minimum) in the form of hard copy declaring their turnover for last 3 (three) Years and details of works completed in Government Department/ PSUs.
- (d) List of similar nature of works completed in last seven years with Government Department/PSUs, showing value of work as completed in a self-explanatory tabular form giving name of work, details about client/Department viz, Address, Telephone, Fax No, E-mail ID etc, date of acceptance of tender/award of work/issue of Order and actual date of completion duly signed by Proprietor/Managing Partner/authorized Director, as applicable.
- (e) List of Works in progress with Government Department/PSUs, Private Bodies/Clients, Local Municipal Bodies showing completed value and balance value to be completed in a self-explanatory tabular form duly signed by Proprietor/Managing Partner/authorized Director, as applicable.
- (f) Solvency Certificate and Working Capital Certificate issued by a Scheduled Bank (not more than three months old).
- (g) Scanned copy of Integrity Pact.
- (h) Scanned copy of GSTIN and EPFO registration/code.

17.3.2 Cover -2 : BOQ /Schedule „A“ duly quoted

17.4 Other documents :

- (a) Declaration (in affidavit form) about existence of any Government dues/ recovery outstanding against the firm.
- (b) Declaration (in affidavit form) about the cases in which the bidder is involved in arbitration/litigation cases giving brief details of such cases. (c) Three photographs of Proprietor/Partners/Director of the firm.
- (c) Declaration (in affidavit form) about near relative(s) of the firm or their employees/ agents is/ are working as Gazetted/ Commissioned Officer in Military Engineer Services/ Corps of Engineers/ Ministry of Defence. If their near relative(s) is /are working in such capacity, bidder shall furnish details.
- (d) Declaration (in affidavit form) about near relative(s) of the contractor is/are working as Junior Engineer in Military Engineer Services/ Corps of Engineers. In case any near relative(s) is/are working in such capacity, bidder shall furnish the details. (f) Declaration (in affidavit form) about existence of „sister concern“ registered in MES.
- (e) Copy of Police verification/clearance certificate from Police authority of the area where the registered office of the firm is located or notarized copy of valid passport of proprietor/each partner/each Director.
- (f) Document regarding Constitution of firm. Affidavit of Sole proprietorship/copy of partnership deed (in case of partnership firms)/ Memorandum & Articles of Association (in case of limited/pvt ltd companies).
- (g) Copies of PAN Card of proprietor/partners/directors

17.5 **Hard copy of the documents as mentioned above will be submitted within 5 (Five) days of the last date & time of opening of „T“ bid (Cover 1).**

18. Important Instructions:

- 18.1 Applications/bids not accompanied by scanned copies of requisite DD/Bankers Cheque towards cost of tender and earnest money deposit (as applicable) shall not be considered for validation of „T“ bid and their finance bids will not be opened.
- 18.2 Tenderers/bidders to note that they should ensure that their original DDs and earnest money deposit (as applicable) are received within 5(Five) days of bid submission end date. Non-submission of physical copies of cost of tender and earnest money deposit (as applicable) shall be considered as willful negligence of the bidder with ulterior motives and such bidder shall be banned from bidding in MES for a period of six months commencing from the date of opening of finance bid.

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- 18.3 In case bidders upload quotation in pre-revised BOQ, the same shall be considered as a willful negligence by the bidder and their quotation shall be considered **Non-bonafide**.
- 18.4 Contractor shall upload copy of Goods and Service Tax (GST) registration certificate of their company. In case of failure to upload and submit the document, the firm shall be disqualified in technical bid evaluation.
- 18.5 Before issue of the Work Order after acceptance of tender, Contractor shall ensure that they have Provident Fund Code number, if applicable, and shall also ensure compliance of EPF & MP Act, 1952.
- 18.6 In case any deficiency is noticed in the documents required to be uploaded by the bidder as per NIT, a communication in the form of e-mail/ Whatsapp /SMS/speed post etc. shall be sent to the bidder after opening of cover 1 (T bid) and technical evaluation with direction to rectify the deficiency and submit the documents as asked for within a period of 7 days from date of communication failing which financial bid (cover-2) shall not be opened and contractor shall not have any claim on the same.
- 18.7 In the technical bid, a scanned copy of Power of Attorney in favour of the person uploading the bid using his/her DSC shall be uploaded. In case the digital signatory himself is the sole proprietor, scanned copy of affidavit on stamp paper of appropriate value to this effect stating that he has authority to bind the firm in all matters pertaining to contract including the Arbitration Clause, shall be attached in „pdf“ form. In case of partnership concern or a limited company, digital signatory of the bid/tender shall ensure that he is competent to bind the contractor (through partnership deed, general power of attorney or Memorandum and Articles of Association of the Company) in all the matters pertaining to the contracts with Union of India including arbitration clause. A scanned copy of the documents confirming of such authority shall be attached with the tender/bid in „pdf“ form, if not submitted earlier. The person uploading the bid on behalf of another partner(s) or on behalf of a firm or company using his DSC shall upload with the tender/bid a scanned copy (in „pdf“ form) of Power of Attorney duly executed in his favour by such other or all of the Partner(s) or in accordance with constitution of the company in case of company, stating that he has authority to bind such other person of the firm or the company, as the case may be, in all matters pertaining to the contract including Arbitration Clause.
- 18.8 Even in case of Firms or Companies which have already given Power of Attorney to an individual authorizing him to sign tender in pursuance of which bids are being uploaded by such person as a routine, fresh Power of Attorney duly executed in his favour stating specifically that the said person has authority to bind such partners of the Firm, or the Company as the case may be, including the condition relating to Arbitration Clause, should be uploaded in „pdf“ form along with the tender/bid; unless such authority has already been given to him by the Firm or the Company. It shall be ensured that power of attorney shall be executed in accordance with the constitution of the company as laid down in its Memorandum & Articles of Association.
19. **Performance Security** : Please refer condition 19 of General Conditions of Contract (IAFW-2249) (as amended under amendment No 47 thereto).

20 EXPERTISE OF EPC MODE OF WORKING (REQUISITE TECHNICAL MANPOWER)

- (i) If the contractor have the requisite in-house expertise for Architectural, Structural and other Engineering Design for B/R and E/M Services then the contractor shall provide details of technical manpower held on their strength. The minimum strength of technical manpower for design and Engineering (Not for execution, which shall be as per General Conditions of Contracts) portion of the work shall be as under:-

- (ii) If however the Contractor does not have the requisite in-house expertise, they shall submit details of MoU with a consultancy firm which has requisite experience of undertaking consultancy of similar nature of projects with amounts not less the estimated cost of the subject work. The consultancy firm is also required to have minimum strength as technical manpower as given in table of note 20 (i) above.

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21 PERFORMANCE & OTHER REQUIREMENT : Bidder shall fulfil the following requirement

- (a) There should not be poor/slow progress in running work. (If yes, submit details and reasons of delay to check that these are not attributable to him or are beyond his control).
- (b) There are no serious defect observed in works which stand un-rectified (If yes, submit details and reasons)
- (c) There are no cancelled/ abandoned contracts in which Govt unrealized recoveries exist (If yes, submit details and reasons)
- (d) He/They have not been blacklisted by any Govt Deptt (If yes, submit details and reasons)
- (e) There is no Government dues outstanding against the firm (If yes, submit details and reasons)
- (f) Proprietor/partners/directors of firm are not involved in anti national/anti social activities and have neither been convicted nor any proceeding are pending in court for such activities
- (h) Firm should have been considered capable of taking more load in work load return circulated by MES. In case the firm is not considered capable for taking more work load due to unsatisfactory performance in the running works, in the prevailing report circulated by MES their technical bid shall be rejected.

22 DISQUALIFICATION: Even though the tenderers meet the above criteria, they are liable to be disqualified if they have made misleading of false information in bidding documents submitted.**23. INTEGRITY PACT (IP) :** IP duly signed by Accepting Officer/Authorized Officer has been uploaded along with this tender as Annexure -II. The same shall be signed by bidder(s) on each page and scanned copy shall be uploaded as part of Technical bid (cover-1) and original IP duly signed on each page shall be forwarded by post alongwith tender fee and EMD (if applicable) . IP will be an integral part of the Contract and both parties are bound by its provision.**24. Q-BID EVALUATION :**

- a. Arithmetical corrections shall be made as per General Condition of Contracts 6A(A) of IAFW 2249.
 - b. Commercial Bids will be reviewed to ensure that the figures indicated therein are consistent with the details of the corresponding Technical bids.
 - c. For the purpose of evaluation "cost" shall be inclusive of all taxes and duties.
 - d. Bidder who has quoted lowest total cost in Schedule „A" (L-1) shall be considered successful bidder and all other bidders shall be considered unsuccessful. Offer of successful bidder (L-1) shall only be considered for acceptance. If L-1 backs out, retendering shall be resorted in a fair and transparent manner.
 - e. Completion Period as indicated in Tender Document have been accepted.
25. If bidders/ tenderers desire that any condition or stipulation given in the tender documents is to be modified/amended or deleted, they may submit their comments/suggestions before last working date of clarification as shown in critical date sheet in subject tender ID alongwith supporting documents, as applicable, for consideration by the Deptt for issue of corrigendum/amendments to tender documents. If deptt considers comments/ suggestions to be appropriate, corrigendum/amendments to tender documents shall be issued and also uploaded on E- tendering Portal. If department does not consider comments/suggestion suitable, corrigendum/amendments to tender documents shall not be issued/uploaded on E- tendering Portal and tenderers shall quote strictly complying with the various provisions given in the tender documents.

26 PROPRIETARY DATA

All documents and other information supplied by the Employer or submitted by a Bidder to the Authority shall remain or become the property of the Authority. Bidders are to treat all information as strictly confidential and shall not use it for any purpose other than for preparation and submission of their Bid. The Authority will not return any Bid or any information provided along therewith.

27 COST OF BIDDING

The Bidders shall be responsible for all of the costs associated with the preparation of their Bids and their participation in the Bidding Process. The Employer will not be responsible or in any way liable for such costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the Bidding Process.

28 SITE VISIT AND VERIFICATION OF INFORMATION

- 28.1 Bidders are encouraged to submit their respective bids after visiting the Project site and ascertaining for themselves the site conditions, soil condition, location, surroundings, climate, availability of power, water & other utilities for construction, access to site, handling and storage of materials, weather data, applicable laws and regulations, and any other matter considered relevant by them by carrying out necessary survey/investigation. Bidders are advised to visit the site and familiarise themselves with the Project within the stipulated time of submission of the Bid. No extension of time is likely to be considered for submission of Bids.

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- 28.2 It shall be deemed that by submitting a Bid, the Bidder has:
- (a) made a complete and careful examination of the Bidding Documents, Schedules annexed to EPC agreement Document;
 - (b) received all relevant information requested from the Employer; accepted the risk of inadequacy, error or mistake in the information provided in the Bidding Documents or furnished by or on behalf of the Authority relating to any of the matters referred to in Clause 22.1 hereinabove. No claim shall be admissible at any stage on this account.
 - (c) satisfied itself about all matters, things and information including matters referred to in Clause 22.1 here-in-above necessary and required for submitting an informed BID, execution of the Project in accordance with the Bidding Documents and performance of all of its obligations there under;
 - (d) acknowledged and agreed that inadequacy, lack of completeness or incorrectness of information provided in the Bidding Documents or ignorance of any of the matters referred to in Clause 22.1 hereinabove shall not be a basis for any claim for compensation, damages, extension of time for performance of its obligations, loss of profits etc. from the Authority, or a ground for termination of the Agreement by the Contractor;
 - (e) acknowledged that it does not have a Conflict of Interest; and
 - (f) agreed to be bound by the undertakings provided by it under and in terms hereof.
- 28.3 The Employer shall not be liable for any omission, mistake or error in respect of any of the above or on account of any matter or thing arising out of or concerning or relating to RFP (Request for proposal) including any error or mistake therein or in any information or data given by the Authority.
29. The contractor may utilize the services of consultants for preparation of architectural details and structural details and preparation of architectural and structural drawings through reputed qualified and experienced consultants in this field. The name of such consultants shall be got approved by the contractor from the Accepting Officer. The consultants proposed by contractor for this purpose shall meet the eligibility criteria for enlistment of consultants corresponding to the applicable Group based on the estimated cost of the work/project as stipulated in the Standard Operating Procedure laid down in Engineering-in-Chief Branch letter No 93348/MISC/Consul/51/E-2 Des-1 dated 06 Mar 2013. While proposing the name of such consultants for approval, the contractor shall enclose the relevant documents in support of the eligibility criteria as mentioned in above letter. The consultant shall be engaged for the work through a proper MOU till completion of project.
30. The contractor shall employ qualified and experienced agents for getting the works of various services executed wherever there is requirement for this purpose as approved by the Accepting Officer or the authorized Engineer Authority on its behalf.
31. In case of rejection of technical /prequalification bid, bidder may appeal to Next Higher Engineer Authority i.e Chief Engineer Western Command on an email id ceengrc1-mes@nic.in with copy to the Accepting Officer on Email before the scheduled date of opening of Cover- 2. NHEA shall decide the matter within a period of seven working days from the date of receipt of appeal. The decision of the NHEA shall be final and binding. The tenderer/bidder shall not be entitled for any compensation whatsoever for rejection of his bid.
32. In case the BOQ is revised through the corrigendum and the bidder has failed to quote on revised BOQ (i.e he has quoted on pre revised BOQ), such bid shall be treated as willful negligence by the bidder and his quotation shall be considered non bonafide. In such cases the lowest tender shall be determined from amongst the valid/bonafide bids only. Accepting Officer may decide whether to re-tender or consider the lowest bonafide tender for acceptance.
33. Revoking the offer or revising the rates upward or offering voluntary reduction by the lowest tenderer after opening of Cover-2 shall be considered as a willful default. For this default a penalty of an amount equal to Earnest money shall be levied. In case of an unenlisted tenderer, Earnest Money deposited by him shall be forfeited. In case of MES enlisted tenderer having deposited the Standing Security Bond, an amount equal to the earnest money stipulated in the NIT, shall be notified to the tenderer for depositing through MRO and consideration of such tenderer in tender evaluation for future works shall remain suspended till the aforementioned amount is deposited in the Government Treasury. No other disciplinary/administrative action shall be taken against such tenderers. In such a situation, the next lowest offer shall not be considered for acceptance. Instead, retendering shall be resorted to in a transparent and fair manner and the defaulting tenderer and his related firm if any, shall not be eligible for this tender in second call or subsequent calls.
34. Court having original jurisdiction over the place from where tender has been issued shall alone have jurisdiction to decide over any dispute out of or in respect of issue related to bidding under this tender. After acceptance of tender, Condition 72 (Jurisdiction of Courts) of General Conditions of Contract (IAFW-2249) shall be applicable.


